REPORT TO THE GERMAN FRIENDS OF THE **ISRAEL MUSEUM JANUARY 2025**

BRIDGING THE GAP 2024/25 - BEGINNING OF THE YEAR REPORT

We are pleased to share that Bridging the Gap has started as planned and on schedule this academic year, despite the challenges and uncertainties due to the ongoing war.

In August 2024, the Yafe Nof (Jewish) and Ein Rafa (Arab) schools confirmed their participation in the coming year's program, which officially began on November 6, 2024. However, two additional schools who were supposed to begin in November as well, Tali Bayit Vagan (Jewish) and Al-Ula (Arab), cancelled their participation only a week before the program was scheduled to start. Their withdrawal came as a result of parental opposition to joint activities during a heightened time of war. Following their decision to withdraw, we immediately reached out to other schools who we believed would be suitable and find interest in participating in the program, and the Keshet School (Jewish) and Abu Ghosh School (Arab) joined the program, with the intention of sending 8th-grade students, aged 13-14).

Learning from last year's insight and experience, we decided to begin this year's program with joint meetings, to introduce the participants, providing a positive and safe environment that allows them to form initial personal connections, a crucial aspect of the program, especially at a time of conflict. A decision was also made to invite the students' parents to the first session. The get together included an introduction the program, followed by a brief tour of the Museum, and a drawing workshop in the Impressionist Gallery led by the program staff.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

As usual, the program is divided into "chapters." The first part of the year will focus on team building, fostering connections among the participants, and introducing them to the Israel Museum and its treasures. In the second part the participating students will delve into this year's annual theme, "Plants," for the 4th grade, and "Animals" for the 8th grade, which will be explored in a in the workshops held in the Youth Wing classrooms, through visits to permanent and temporary exhibitions in the Museum, and a special visit to the Jerusalem Botanical Gardens and the Jerusalem Biblical Zoo. the participants will work in groups, collaborate on a final project. The 8th graders will initiate a puppet theatre with animals' poppets that will be presented to the 4th graders and the parents at the final session.

PROGRAM FRAMEWORK AND ANNUAL OVERVIEW

 As of November 2024, Bridging the Gap activities take place in the Israel Museum, every Wednesday and Thursday afternoon, between 4:00 and 6:00 PM, and are scheduled to run through the beginning of June 2025, as outlined below.

• On Wednesdays, we welcome a total of 30 students:

- 12 Jewish students on 4th grade, from the Yafe Nof School, located in Beit Hakerem, Jerusalem.
- 18 Arab students, on 4th grade from Ein Rafa school, located in Ein Rafa, a village near Jerusalem.
- 22 sessions are planned to take place on Wednesdays, from November
 6, 2024 June 4, 2025.

• On Thursdays, we welcome a total of 28 students:

- o 10 Jewish students on 8th grade, from Keshet School in Jerusalem.
- 18 Arab students on 8th grade from Abu Ghosh, a local council near Ierusalem.
- 19 sessions are planned to take place on Thursdays, from November 28, 2024 – June 5, 2025.

In 2025, aligning with the Ramadan and Passover holidays, the program will take a break During the month of March and April. The students' parents will be invited to two special meetings, scheduled in January and April 2025. The annual activity schedule is provided in the appendix.





FUNDING REQUEST

As you know, Bridging the Gap is also partially funded each year by the Hans Seidel Foundation which has been an essential source of support for the past 7 years. However, the Foundation has updated us that they will not be able to secure their annual contribution to the program this year.
